

Overview of updates within 2023.0 NIBRS Technical Specifications

Error Codes Removed:

- Error 173
- Error 560
- Error 459
- Error 930

Error/Warnings Added:

- Warning 1198 - Delete record was submitted with an incident date that does not match the incident date on the previously submitted incident that resides in our database.
- Warning 1451 - Data Element 26 (Age of Victim) was submitted with an unreasonable range span from the youngest age of 01 to the oldest age of 98 or 99.
- Warning 1551 - Data Element 37 (Age of Offender) was submitted with an unreasonable range span from the youngest age of 01 to the oldest age of 98 or 99.
- Warning 1651 - Data Element 47 (Age of Arrestee) in a Group A Incident Report was submitted with an unreasonable range span from the youngest age of 01 to the oldest age of 98 or 99.
- Warning 1751 - Data Element 47 (Age of Arrestee) in a Group B arrest was submitted with an unreasonable range span from the youngest age of 01 to the oldest age of 98 or 99.

Description Changes (Logic Change):

- Error 085 – Replaced Crime Against Property with Robbery.
- Error 105 – Added, The date cannot be later than that entered within the Month of Electronic submission and Year of Electronic submission fields on the data record. For example, if Month of Electronic submission and Year of Electronic submission are 06/1999, the recovered date cannot contain any date 07/01/1999 or later. Also, the date cannot exceed the current date.
- Error 352 – Removed Exception 2 (Data Element 20 Exception 2 – The incident consists of multiple property segments where at least one property segment contains Seized in Data Element 14 (Type Property Loss/Etc.)
- Error 392 – Removed Exception 2 (Exception 2-The incident consists of multiple Property Sections where at least one Property Sections contains Seized in Data Element 14 (Type Property Loss/Etc.), and 10 = Drugs/Narcotics in Data Element 15 (Property Description).

Description Change (No Logic Change):

- Error 470 – Removed, However, there may be some situations where only one of the victims is also the offender, but where the other victim(s) is not also the offender(s).
- Error 931 – Error message changed (THE ORI INFORMATION IS DUPLICATED IN THE REFERENCE DATA)
- Error 931 – Error description changed (The ORI already exists in the reference table for a different agency. Verify that the ORI is accurate.)
- Offender Number to be Related – Mandatory Condition change (This data element is mandatory when one of the offenses entered in Data Element 24 (Victim Connected to UCR Offense Code) is a Crime Against Person or a Crime Against Property (in case of Robbery), when Data Element 25 (Type of Victim) is I = Individual or L = Law Enforcement. Reporting the relationship of victim to offender for Crime Against Property offenses is optional for victims of I = Individual, other than 120 = Robbery.

Data Element 35 (Relationship of Victim to Offender) – New Values:

This will change the logic and description of Warning 1413

- FC = Foster Child
- FP = Foster Child

Change in Bias Motivation Description:

- 28 = Anti-Church of Jesus Christ

Two changes made in the 2023 NIBRS updates do not apply as they were updated in 2023:

- Removed Location 22 = School (*removed in July 2023*)
- Removed Arrest Offense Codes 90A = Bad Checks, 90E = Drunkenness, and 90H = Peeping Tom (*removed in July 2023*)
